## **Carnegie Avenue Rehabilitation Project – Phase 1**

(East 55<sup>th</sup> Street to East 79<sup>th</sup> Street)

### **Public Information Presentation**

**When:** October 3, 2023; 5:00 pm – 7:00 pm

**Where:** Cleveland Foundation, 6601 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44103

**What:** To provide feedback from question/comments asked at the first Design Public Meeting, which occurred on May 10, 2023

The proposed improvements include:

- Full and partial depth pavement repairs as needed, and complete asphalt resurfacing
- New sidewalk, ADA-compliant curb ramps and drive aprons as necessary
- Replacement of an existing 8" water main with a 12" water main from East 55<sup>th</sup> Street to East 65<sup>th</sup> Street. Replacement of an existing 8" water main with a new 8" water main from East 65<sup>th</sup> Street to East 79<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Narrowing of the roadway and expanding the sidewalk under the Norfolk Southern Bridge with one lane in each direction separated by a two-way left turn lane
- Replacement of existing catch basins as needed
- Adding a high visibility crosswalk and Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB) north of the Private Drive at 6555 Carnegie Avenue
- Signal upgrades at East 71<sup>st</sup> Street
- Removal of signal and crossing east of East 77<sup>th</sup> Street and adding a RRFB west of East 77<sup>th</sup> Street
- Adding medians & RRFBs to improve crossings at 6555 Carnegie and west of East 77<sup>th</sup> Street
- Removing concrete tree lawns and replacing with grass tree lawn in certain areas and coordinating with Urban Forestry to add trees where feasible

**Construction Cost:** \$9.6 million

**Funding Sources:** Ohio Public Works Commission-Issue 1, City Road & Bridge Bonds and Public Utility Funds

**Schedule:** Bids will be submitted in late October 2023. Construction is expected to start in late March 2024 and be completed in mid-2025.
